**Carpets made of PA all over printed with Acid dyes (chromo jet) and Acid ink digital print, PP colored, PES and recycle Polyester dyed and their mixture between each other. All backed with secondary backing (super Cotton Canvas, PP action back), laminated by latex, or coated with foam (colored or not) or black PVC or TBR (colored or not). All with Polyester woven tapes or PP BCF single over locking edges. Includes sewing threads, polyester woven labels & printed labels on (polyester & cotton tapes). PP grass and PP/PES green grass landscape with self-finish edges coated with latex”**

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 6, **product class IV** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 6 for decoration material.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).
